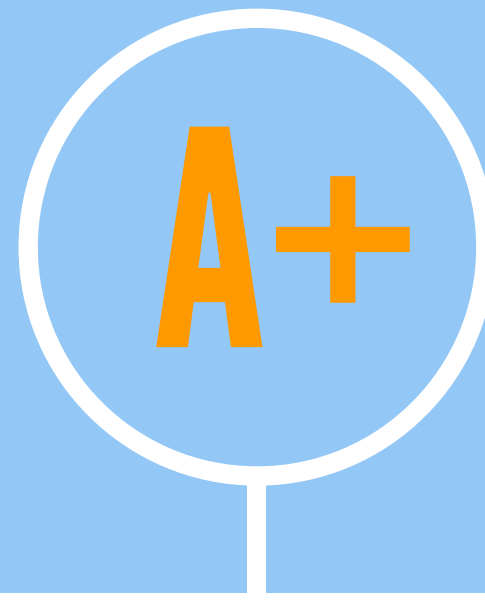

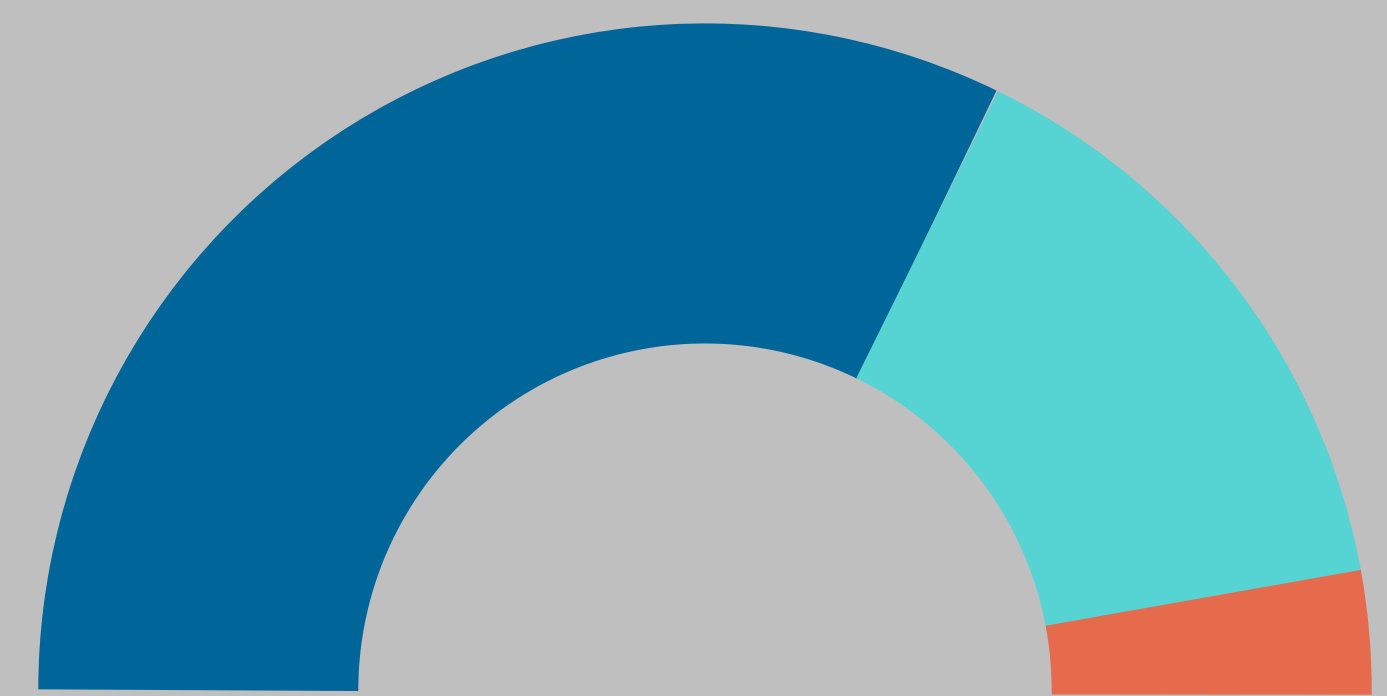

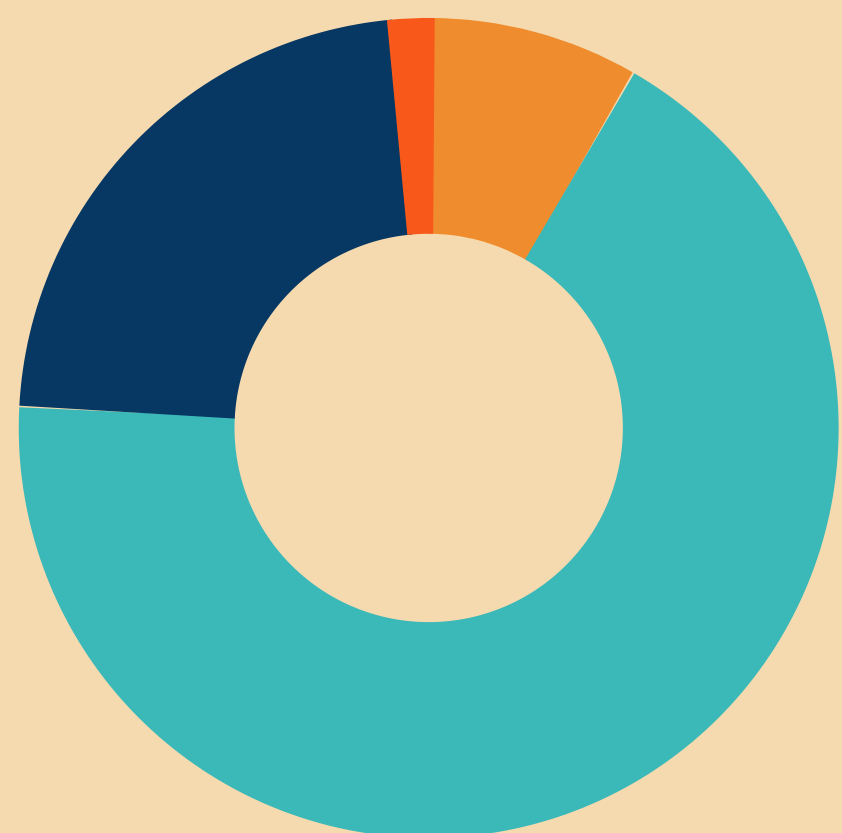

Reading Level Breakdown

Below is how 2nd grade students starting at a Kinder, 1st grade, or 2nd grade Reading Level (RL) finished the school year.

Starting at Kinder RL

(22% of all Students)

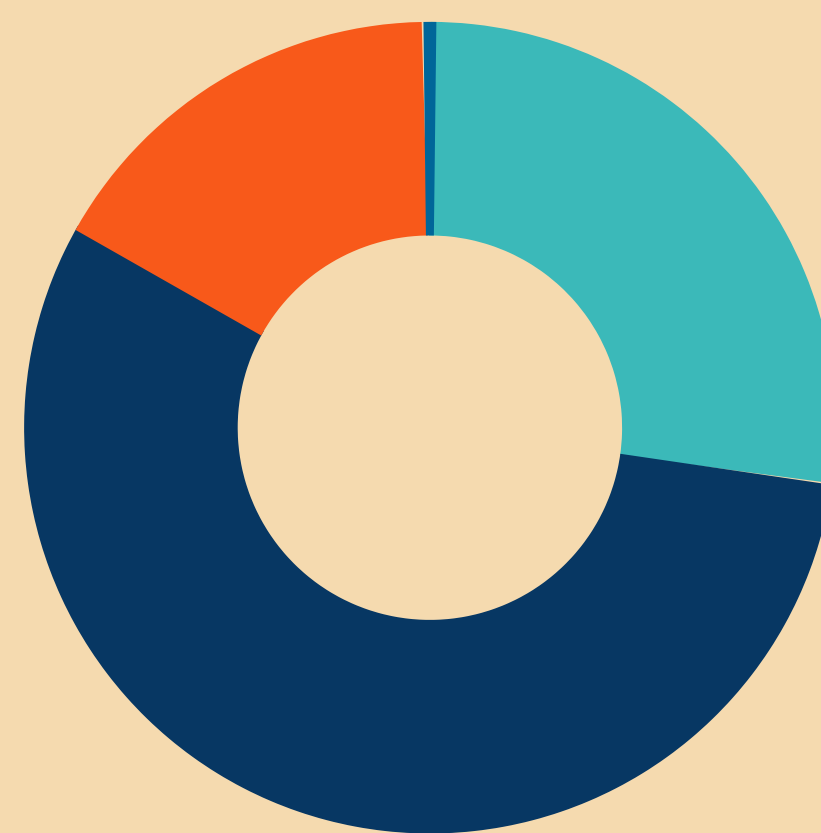


Ended the year reading at the following levels:

(77% of all Students)



Ended the year reading at the following levels:

1st - 27%
2nd - 55%
3rd - 16%

Starting at 2nd RL

(1% of all Students)



Ended the year reading at the following levels:

1st - 12%
2nd - 35%
3rd - 53%



40,000+ Books Distributed

The SAYL Book Buddies Initiative distributed a total of 35,095 books to students in grades Pre-K through 7th grade at 13 SAISD schools. In addition, SAYL Book Buddies also gave out 3,400 books for students who participated in the SAYL Reading Buddy Program this year, plus an additional 2,000 books were given to 4 partner organizations making the grand total of books distributed over 40,000.

An average of 15 sessions per student were completed by SAYL Reading Buddy volunteers. Each session is based on a 30-minute time block equaling...

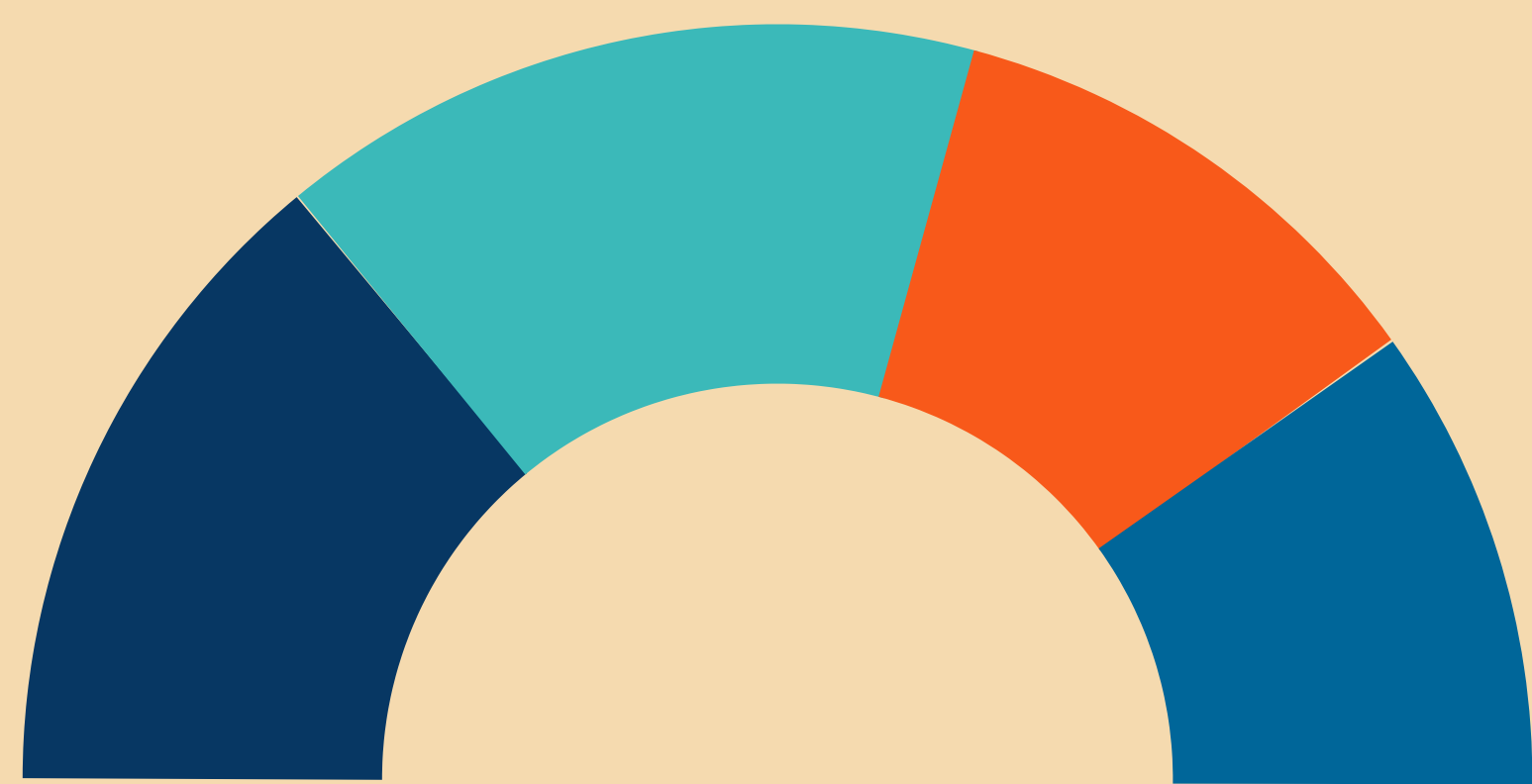
